

State and its stakeholders

The state's stakeholders include

- Internal: national citizens, foreigners, domestic & foreign business organizations, NGO's
- External: other states, foreign citizens, expats, foreign business organizations, NGO's

Relationships

Inbound flow 1: the domestic environment influences the state relative to the productive resources (L, K) the state needs, citizen's demands & needs, business's demands and needs, infrastructure

Inbound flow 2: the foreign environment influences the state in terms of the imported productive resources (L, K), foreign policies, economic conditions and trends, international cooperation, regional security

Outbound flow 1: the state impacts on the domestic environment by setting policies and the legal framework, improving the infrastructure, and providing benefits

Outbound flow 2: the state impacts on the foreign environment by means of its economic and security policies, and international aid
